



ORDER OF THE LAW CLERK

Re: Elections Act Amendment Act UTS 52/2018

Enacted under the Grammatical and Typographical Amendments Act UTS 42/2014 section 2.1

UTO 01/2018

BACKGROUND:

- A. On February 15, 2018 Council enacted the Elections Act Amendment Act UTS 52/2018 (the "Act");
- B. By letter dated March 1, 2018 legal counsel for the Uchucklesaht government advised the law clerk that, through inadvertence, the Act contains grammatical and typographical errors;
- C. In accordance with section 2.1 of the Grammatical and Typographical Amendments Act UTS 42/2014, the law clerk may, by Order and on the advice of legal counsel to the Uchucklesaht government, make an amendment to an enactment to correct a grammatical or typographical error in that enactment, provided that amendment does not in any way alter the intent of, or a right, duty or power provided for in, that enactment.

NOW THEREFORE THE LAW CLERK ORDERS AS FOLLOWS:

- 1) The Elections Act Amendment Act UTS 52/2018 is amended as follows:
 - a) section 2.1(d) is amended by striking out "(e) and (f)" in the first line of the substituted section 11.2(c) and substituting "(d) and (e)", and renumbering the substituted sections 11.2(e) and (f) to (d) and (e).
- 2) This Order is deemed to have come into force on February 15, 2018 and is retroactive to the extent necessary to give it effect on and after that date.
