




Uu-a-thluk Fisheries Intern (Term Employment)



Uu-a-thluk (NTC Fisheries Department), is seeking a term, full-time Fisheries Intern to join our team from May to September, 2019 performing fisheries management activities. Based out of Port Alberni, the position will involve frequent travel to all Nuu-chah-nulth territories.

Job Overview:

Activities will include a variety of fisheries management projects and duties, such as fisheries enforcement and compliance monitoring, monitoring and assessments of salmon, ground fish, crabs, prawns and gooseneck barnacles, data processing, research and writing. Based on the successful candidate's interests, the fisheries internship position will vary in focus. Uu-a-thluk staff will provide training and mentoring in relevant job skills.

Dates: End of May – September, 2019 (*flexible start and end dates, duration pending funding*)

Wage: \$16.85/hr for 37.5 hr/week

Preferred Qualifications:

- Minimum of a high school diploma/GED plus a strong interest in a career in natural resource management
- Relevant post-secondary education, and fisheries program experience considered an asset
- Between 19 and 30 years of age at the start of the employment
- A desire to do field work
- Comfort around water, fishers and boats
- Good physical fitness
- The ability to work independently and as part of a team
- The ability to travel, occasionally overnight
- Strong written and verbal communications skills
- Computer skills such as Microsoft Office (i.e., Word, Excel, PowerPoint)
- A driver's license, and a reliable vehicle is considered an asset
- Provide acceptable criminal record check
